PROTECT YOURSELF WITH THESE SIMPLE STEPS:



LIMIT PERSONAL SHARING

Avoid posting sensitive information online e.g., birthdays, addresses, etc.



BE CAUTIOUS WITH FRIEND REQUESTS

Verify the identity of new contacts before accepting requests on social media.



USE STRONG & UNIQUE PASSWORDS

Use complex passwords and avoid using the same password across platforms.



ENABLE TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION (2FA)

Enable 2FA to reduce the risk of unauthorised access to your personal data.



BEWARE OF PHISHING SCAMS

Be cautious of unexpected messages, links, or requests for personal information. Always verify the sender before clicking anything.



STAY UPDATED REGULARLY

Update your social media apps and device software regularly to protect yourself against vulnerabilities that could be exploited by hackers.


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
